



Interagency Collaboration Policy

The Lindenhurst Memorial Library will collaborate with agencies, governmental entities and organizations on a local, state, or national level as those organizations relate to the Library's mission , goals and objectives and serve the mutual interests of the Library and these entities.

Collaboration may entail the use of Library facilities, collections, and/or staff. Any financial support by other organizations will be reviewed by the Library's Board of Trustees, whose decision will be guided by Board policy, the By-laws of Lindenhurst Memorial Library, and the New York State and federal laws.

The Library participates in the Suffolk Share program, a local governmental shared services plan designed to achieve tax savings through the sharing of services by local municipal governments.
