

**Press and Public Media Policy** 

If members of the media (radio, television, newspapers, social media outlets) contact

the Lindenhurst Memorial Library for any official statement regarding policies, practices,

or procedures at the Library, or information about specific programs, materials, etc., the

following personnel are authorized to speak on behalf of the Library:

Library Director or Assistant Library Director

Librarian III

President of the Library Board of Trustees

Other staff may speak on behalf of the Library in specific situations with prior

authorization from the Library Director or his/her designee. It is expected that staff

speaking on behalf of the Library will exercise good judgement and participate in the

interaction in a productive and responsible way with the best interests of the Library and

the overall community in mind.

Members of the print, broadcast media or other persons or entities, must obtain

permission from the Director or his/her designee prior to entering the building to take

photographs or to conduct interviews anywhere on Library property. The photographing

of specific persons may be subject to laws requiring authorization from the person

photographed, prior to dissemination and/or use.
