I agree to abide by library rules regarding behavior, public computer use and borrowing materials. I agree to pay for any loss of, or damage to, library materials, and to pay overdue fees accumulated on this card. I am responsible for notifying the Library in case of loss or theft of this card. I understand failure to do so will result in my being held liable for materials on this card and any fees incurred. I agree to inform the Library of any changes to the above information. If I'm a parent or guardian, I understand I am responsible for all lost or damaged charges on a youth card, and that while youth cards are free of overdue fees (excluding new dvds and all video games), lost or damaged item charges still apply.

The Library has an open access policy to its materials and information sources, which means the Library does not restrict access to items in the collection, or limit access to the Internet, except in accordance with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA). The Library utilizes filtering software to block access to some Internet sites on Library's public computers and through the Library's wireless network. **Parents or legal guardians must assume responsibility for deciding which library resources, both print and online, are appropriate for their own child.**

Parents/guardians may choose to restrict access to physical materials by registering their child for a limited access library card. Limited access cards can only borrow material from within the children's department. Once a child is issued a limited access card, there will be no exceptions made to the circulation policy until the parent/guardian comes to the library to upgrade the account to a youth plus card with additional access. Youth plus library card accounts **exclude the following items from being borrowed: Museum Passes, Wi-Fi hotspots, Launchpads, Starlings, and streaming devices.**

- I want my child to have a **limited access library card** that can only borrow material in the children's department. Note: this includes children DVDs and video games. It excludes Launchpads and Starlings.
- I want my child to have a **youth plus library card** that can borrow materials, including DVDs and video games, from the youth, YA, and adult collections, except as noted above.
