

Streaming Devices Circulation Policy

The Lindenhurst Memorial Library, at its discretion, will make streaming devices available for adult cardholders in good standing patron (no fines or overdue items). Device checkout is limited to one per bar code for a period of 7 days, with one renewal, providing there are no holds on the device. The Library reserves the right to refuse service to patrons who abuse equipment or who are late in returning materials. The Library is not responsible for any liability, damages or expense resulting from use or misuse of the device, connection of the device to other electronic devices, or data loss resulting from use of device.

Each streaming device is preloaded with selected accounts and content, in accordance with Library collection policies. Borrowers may not download or delete any titles, accounts, or content from the Streaming device. Patrons may not attempt to log-out of the Library's account and into their own account on the streaming device.

The Library is not responsible for any costs incurred while borrowers use the equipment. Please note that a WiFi connection is required to use a streaming device. Since content is streamed over the internet, the device will not function without an internet connection.

Streaming devices are not considered returned until all items, including charging cables, within the case have been returned to the Library in working condition. If any items are missing upon return, the Library reserves the right to refuse acceptance of the equipment until all items are returned. Late fees are to be charged, in addition to any charges for streaming devices and components not returned in their original working condition.
