Summer @ LML Frequently Asked Questions

General FAQs

Who can participate?

Babies, toddlers, preschoolers, children, teens, adults—everyone! Children who are too young to read by themselves can participate with an adult. Parents or caretakers are welcome to sign young children up and read to them.

How do I join?

Either download the READSquared app or use [this link](#) to sign up. If you do not have Internet access or would prefer to do things offline, request a pick up packet by emailing us at summer@lindenhurstlibrary.org

How do I create a family account?

If you are a parent or guardian and would like to create a family account to manage your children's accounts, simply follow the directions to create an account for yourself, then follow the prompts to register your children. If you have already created an account for yourself, log in and click on the "Account" button on the top menu of your screen, then select "Add Child Account." If your child also already has an account, select "Link Existing Account."

How do I get a library card for myself or my child?

Go to the library's [website](#) and scroll down to the About Us section, then click on Get a Library Card.

When can I start logging books and activities?

June 15th.

Can I count books that I read on my computer or e-reader?

Of course! It's all the same to us.

Can I count audiobooks?

You bet!



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Can I join the program after its official start date?

Of course! And if you can remember any reading time that you've done since the program's official start date, you're welcome to go back and count that.

Can I count reading time that I did before the official start date?

We ask that you count only reading you've done within the official dates of the program, June 15–August 15, 2020.

I forgot my password. How can I retrieve it?

You can retrieve your password via email. From the Login page, click on "Did you forget your password? Get it by email."

I forgot my username. How can I retrieve it?

I received an email that says I earned my achievement certificate. Can the library print the certificate for me?

We encourage you to print your certificate at home or save an electronic version. If you would like a print copy, the Children's Department will have some pre-printed certificates.



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Birth-Not Entering Kindergarten FAQs

How do I record books that I read?

Because we are using the Bingo board this year, there is no official logging of books read. But if you would like to keep track, you can request a Summer @ LML journal by emailing us at summer@lindenhurstlibrary.org.

How many points am I allowed to submit per day in the Early Childhood Program (Birth-not entering Kindergarten)? Why?

200. Because we want to keep you coming back every day!

How many points do I need in order to receive the 5 prize levels in the Early Childhood Program (Birth-not entering Kindergarten)?

Prize Level 1 = 200 points (each activity on the Bingo board is worth 40 points)

Prize Level 2 = 400 points

Prize Level 3 = 600 points

Prize Level 4 = 800 points

Prize Level 5 = 1000 points

How do I complete the Early Childhood Program?

Children ages birth thru not entering kindergarten will complete 25 activities on their Bingo board to complete the program.

Do I have to complete the missions?

No, missions are just extra challenges for you. They are only for fun. They have no point value. But you'll earn extra raffle tickets for completing them, so don't forget to do the missions!



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Grades K-5 FAQs

How do I record books that I read?

Because we are using the Bingo board this year, there is no official logging of books read. But if you would like to keep track, you can request a Summer @ LML journal by emailing us at summer@lindenhurstlibrary.org.

How many points am I allowed to submit per day in the Kids program (Grades K-5)? Why?

200. Because we want to keep you coming back every day! ☺

How many points do I need in order to receive the 5 prize levels in the Kids Program (Grades K-5)?

Prize Level 1 = 200 points (each activity on the Bingo board is worth 50 points)

Prize Level 2 = 400 points

Prize Level 3 = 600 points

Prize Level 4 = 800 points

Prize Level 5 = 1000 points

How do I complete the kids club?

Children in grades K-5 will complete 20 activities on their Bingo board to complete the program.

Do I have to complete the missions?

No, missions are just extra challenges for you. They are only for fun. They have no point value. But you'll earn extra raffle tickets for completing them, so don't forget to do the missions!



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Grades 6-12 FAQs

How do I record books that I read?

Because we are using the Bingo board this year, there is no official logging of books read. But if you would like to keep track, you can request a Summer @ LML journal by emailing us at summer@lindenhurstlibrary.org.

How many points am I allowed to submit per day in the Teen program (Grades 6-12)? Why?

200. Because we want to keep you coming back every day!

How do I complete the teen club?

Teens in grades 6-12 will complete 3 activities on their Bingo board to complete the program. Each activity or square gives you one raffle ticket towards the raffle at the end of the summer. To earn extra raffle tickets and more chances to win prizes, you can complete the remaining 6 squares.

Do I have to complete the missions?

No, missions are just extra challenges for you. They are only for fun. They have no point value. But you'll earn extra raffle tickets for completing them, so don't forget to do the missions!



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Adult FAQs

How do I record books that I read?

Because we are using the Bingo board this year, there is no official logging of books read or audio books listened to. But if you would like to keep track, you can request a Summer @ LML journal by emailing us at summer@lindenhurstlibrary.org.

How many points am I allowed to submit per day in the Adult Program?

80 points or two bingo squares a day.

How many activities on the Bingo board do I need to complete the program?

You can complete as many as you wish. Just remember, a raffle ticket is awarded in 200 point increments for rows completed and only 2 squares can be completed per day.

Level One – 200 points = 1 raffle ticket

Level Two – 400 points = 1 raffle tickets (total 2 raffle tickets)

Level Three – 600 points = 1 raffle ticket 3 raffle tickets total)

Level Four – 800 points = 1 raffle ticket (4 total tickets)

Level Five – 1000 points = 1 raffle ticket + 1 raffle ticket toward the Grand Prize Drawing!

Entire Bingo Board = 5 raffle tickets + 1 Grand Prize raffle ticket
